

From the Pastor

Hello friends,

I have a smattering of reflection and business for you this weekend.

First, an announcement. Given the scale of Coon Valley's parish picnic a few weeks ago, I have officially rebranded it (in my mind) as "SummerFest," (end of announcement). I've also mentioned the upcoming Viroqua parish picnic (August 27 at Eckhert Park, after the 10:30 Mass), and several folks have asked me with a coy little grin, "Is Viroqua gonna go that big?" Great question, and the short answer is, "Not at all, and that's really good." The slightly longer answer is "Not at all, and that's really good, because they're two very different things." SummerFest (in my mind) served the excellent purpose of reaching out to the Coon Valley/Westby/Chaseburg/Viroqua area, drawing our Catholic and non-Catholic friends together to enjoy a beautiful afternoon together and generate some excellent energy. Viroqua's upcoming Parish Picnic is very much geared inward toward our Catholic community – a chance for our kids to run around together, to say goodbye to summer and to welcome a new school year, and a moment to recreate with each other. The former goes wide, the latter goes deep, and a healthy community needs both. Thank you to everyone who did make/is making these events happen!

Second, a reminder that this Monday/Tuesday we'll be celebrating the Assumption, also a Holy Day of Obligation. Thanks to a scheduling hiccup that's entirely my fault, I won't be here, but Msgr. Kachel and his associate Fr. Tim will celebrate Masses according to the schedule: August 14 at 5:15 and August 15 at 12:10 in Viroqua, August 15 at 5:15 in Coon Valley. August 16 is also my mother's birthday, but that's not really relevant here. With me out of town there will also not be Mass Wednesday through Friday, although there will be a Communion service and adoration Wednesday evening from 5:15-6:30 in Viroqua.

Finally, a note of gratitude. One of my seminary professors once dropped a wisdom bomb on us: "Men, make sure you take your vacation, A) so you can get away from your people, and B) so that your people can get away from you." I'll be up in the Boundary Waters next week and swinging through the Northwoods for a few days after, which of course means I won't be here. Given that my schedule has a fairly public impact you might be thinking to yourself, "gosh this guy is away a lot," which is a fair thing to think. Parish priests have a pretty generous vacation package (allowed up to four weeks a year); pair that with our annual weeklong retreat and other business away from the parish, and "gosh this guy is away a lot," makes some sense. Anyway, I try to space that time strategically so as to miss as few weekends as possible and also to stay ahead of my own needed recovery and re-creation. The simple truth is that there's an emotional and spiritual cost to Pastoring, and this type of time away is an invaluable part of the sharpening kit that keeps my life and leadership in some kind of order. Thank you for carrying the real burden of not having the Pastor around for some time, and I'll see you on August 22!


