

#### From the Pastor

Hello friends,

There's been a lot going on lately and a few schedule changes, so let me use this weekend's bulletin to share a few updates concerning April 2023's status quo.

- Weekday Mass Schedule: After praying the Stations at 5:15 during Lent and after gathering a consensus preference among our weekday Mass regulars and Pastoral Councils, we have officially changed the Tuesday (in Coon Valley) and Wednesday (in Viroqua) Masses from 6:30 PM to 5:15 PM, effective immediately. The Thursday (Coon Valley) and Friday (Viroqua) 8:00 AM and weekend Masses stay unaffected.

My brothers and I take a retreat every year as part of our ongoing formation and as one of many necessary necessities to maintain our spiritual health, and this week will be a good moment to take stock of the last year and prepare for what's ahead. This also means there will not be daily Masses that week in Coon Valley or Viroqua, although the weekend schedule remains unaffected.

That's it for this week. I'm writing this article a few days after Holy Week and unpacking the experience we just shared, and in short I am grateful for how everyone came together to pray, how both Coon Valley and Viroqua worked together on the liturgies, and for the way the Holy Spirit keeps drawing us deeper and deeper into the resurrection. God bless you all, and thank you for trusting me with this pastoral responsibility!




