

- Attend Mass and drop your contribution envelope at either church, Coon Valley or Viroqua and the funds will be directed to St. Mary's

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

If you are 70 ½ or older, you can do a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) of up to \$100,000 a year from your IRA directly to a charity. The distribution won't show up in your adjusted gross income and CAN count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD). The QCD allows you to be more strategic with your RMD. Consult your tax advisor before making any decisions. If a QCD is for you, please consider St. Mary's Parish as your charity of choice.



## From the Pastor

Hello friends,

Two quick notes from Fr. Joe:

First, next weekend St. Mary's in Viroqua is hosting a parish picnic at Eckhert Park after the 10:30 Mass – head on down and enjoy some fine grilled meats and time with each other in the (hopeful) 74 degree sun!

Second, last week we mentioned that **Fr. Michael is here this weekend for our annual Mission appeal**. These appeals are given throughout the Diocese by various missionary parties to support the work they do. Here's a note from the Missions Office about what Fr. Michael is sharing with us this weekend:

<u>The MCP Mission Appeal</u> is authorized by Most Reverend Damiano Guzzetti, Bishop of Moroto Diocese in northeast Uganda. A priest of the diocese, Fr. Michael Apurio is his representative. The appeal focuses on the following needs and seeks prayers and financial contributions to see them completed:

- 1. To support the rural apostolate by empowering and facilitating evangelizing ministers through training and formation of future priests, religious and catechists.
- 2. To support diocesan health programs for war victims, orphans, the aged, HIV/AIDS patients and their families, widows and widowers. Other programs seek to grow the evangelization and strengthening of Christian families. Many children are left orphaned because of HIV/AIDS and previous violence during episodes of cattle rustling. The diocese provides care and support to these children.
- 3. To support youth ministry by promoting youth training, sports activities, retreats for moral and spiritual formation, vocational training at Naoi Diocesan Technical School. Since many youths are school dropouts and are jobless, they become vulnerable to crime, alcohol, and drug abuse: they go gambling and engage in criminal activities. The diocese tries to evangelize both rural and school youth.
- 4. To support education in Catholic founded schools. The diocese invests in education to improve the human condition of the people. Currently, the illiteracy rate is very high, nearly 90% of the people have not had school education. A majority are pastoralists and survive on subsistence living under hostile climate conditions. An orphanage in Naoi Parish, currently with one building, needs second classroom building to provide a learning environment for children without parents. Support for seminaries and education of girl-child prone to forced marriages for bride wealth, are among the many areas of need.
- 5. To support social services and development programs in order to provide safe water sources for parishes and sustainable livelihood with food security and the promotion of peasant farming.

Any support you are able to offer is appreciated and valuable. Please use the envelopes provided. Donations are to be sent to the parish and will be forwarded in total to the Mission Office. Tax credit will be included on your Year End parish tithing statement. Thank you for your prayers and the sacrifices you make on behalf of the people in Moroto Diocese. God bless.
